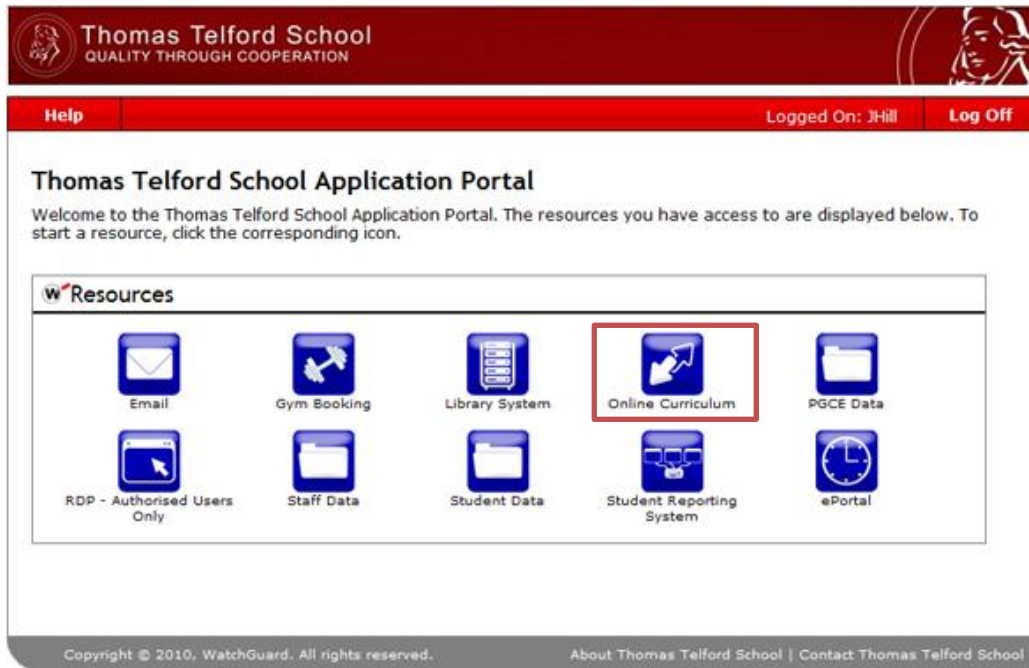


Student & Parent Help – Online Curriculum Access from home

Students can access the entire online curriculum from school and at home.

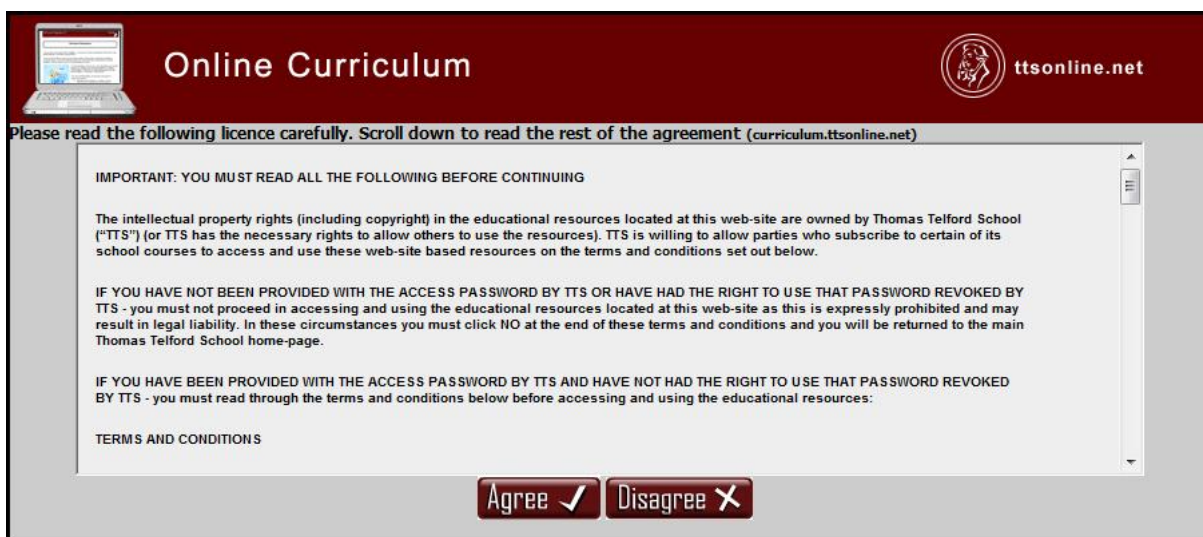
From home you will need to go to <http://vo.ttsonline.net> and use your username and password to log in. (There is a separate help guide for this if needed.)

A licence agreement box will appear. Just select **Agree** to gain access to the curriculum.

















You have now successfully accessed the curriculum where you will see all of the Curriculum subjects.

If you are running RealPlayer version 10 you need to make sure that Real-Time Streaming Protocol is enabled. To enable RTSP click on Tools on the RealPlayer menu bar then select Preferences. In the popup window open the Content category and select Media Types. Click on the Advanced tab and in the Other Media section of the popup window tick the box alongside Real-Time Streaming Protocol.

Menu Structure

All subjects will have a left hand menu. To navigate around the site use the plus sign (+) next to each year/unit/page to view the full contents. Then select the title of the page you want to view.

Additional Curriculum features

Each subject will also have this menu



Back - This back button works the same as the back button on your browser.

Print - To print resources use the print button provided.

Search - The search facility allows you to find resources when you're unable to find them via the menu.

Hide - show button will allow you to hide the menu bar when viewing a resource and then allow you to show it again when you want to use the menu.

Curriculum - The curriculum button takes you back to the front page of the curriculum allowing you to select other subject areas.
